



Warranty for Installation of WPC Products over Radiant Heat

Brandywine International Hardwood (BIH) warrants the use of its WPC products over properly installed radiant heat systems. BIH will retain all product warranties on this product.

Radiant heat systems should be used according to the manufacturer's instructions and must not ever exceed a temperature of 80° Fahrenheit (27° Celcius) in any location. Excessive heat, rapid heating, and/or failure to maintain humidity levels between 35% and 65% are likely to cause increased expansion, cupping, edge breakage, gaps and other forms of expansion related issues. Increased expansion should be expected in installations over radiant heat and does not constitute a product failure. One should consider increasing the amount of expansion space over radiant heat systems along all fixed objects. Larger areas can experience more overall expansion when temperature increases. Avoid or protect areas against intense direct sunlight.

For installations over 2,000 square feet, an environmental monitoring system (datalogger) should be installed to protect the consumers investment and assure that proper conditions are maintained during the life of the floor. More information about these systems can be provided upon request.
